On November 5, 2024, the Philoptochos Board met and voted to support many upcoming ministries, plan some wonderful future events, and share the successes of recent events.

**Metropolis News** – Light the Path 2024 in Southern California will be held on November 17, 2024, at the Los Coyotes Country Club in Buena Park, California. The event begins at 2pm and you can still register on the email you have received until November 12. This ministry provides a financial lifeline to our seminarians.

**Treasury and Budget** – Hana Keilo presented the financial report and some questions were answered. We are current with the payment of all our commitments.

**Father's Announcements** – Our Holy Cross Christmas tree sale will begin on the Tuesday before Thanksgiving. Father announced that the Family Sharing Program will help 50 families this year.

**Feed the Hungry Report** – We are currently making 420 sandwiches each week, half of which go to Samaritan House and half to the Life Moves Program. We thank parishioners of all ages who come to help. Most of our ingredients are donated by Costco and Samaritan House. Philoptochos is underwriting the program with between \$200 and \$220 per month. Thank you to Emmy Denton for continuing to chair this most worthy effort!

**Life Moves** – Under Nina Azar's lead, we are preparing and serving a wonderful fall family meal to the 125 residents of the Life Moves program. Members of our Board and our parish are preparing and serving this delicious chicken dinner with all the trimmings. Our Philoptochos has allocated \$360 in addition to donated items for this event. There will likely be another family dinner some time before Easter, 2024

**National Philoptochos Convention** – Barbara Karvelis is putting together a summary of the takeaways and great ideas learned from the convention, including how to build community, ways to increase our membership, and staying healthy to help others.

**Budget 2024-2025** – After reviewing the proposed budget, the Board voted to approve the final budget with several small changes. This is an effort we have been working on for some time.
