THE 2026-2027 DANCE YEAR WILL BEGIN in

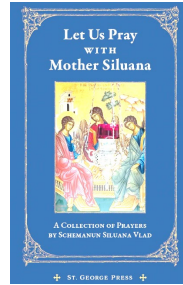
